- We received the offer letter from Darwin Initiative on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021. We worked on completing the requested forms until 09<sup>th</sup> September.
- On 24<sup>th</sup> August, MV and Mitsinjo team held a meeting in Andasibe to review the project activities, timeline and budget.
- In September, we attended the workshops organized by the Darwin Initiative on communications, monitoring and evaluation, common issues and complementarities.
- On 08th September, we held the first full project team meeting virtually. We decided on the need to run project meeting monthly to monitor progress and take key decisions. These meetings will be held on the first Wednesday of each month.
- On 23<sup>rd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> September, Youssouf from Mitsinjo Association carried out a fieldwork in Mangabe Protected Area to verify the natural regeneration of the *Tambourissa* species which is available for the project. The seed collect is therefore necessary for the production of this species.
