1. Outline progress over the last 6 months against the agreed baseline timetable for the project (if your project has started less than 6 months ago, please report on the period since start up).

The project formally commenced in September 2003. However, press releases announcing the project award occurred in April 2003. An e-mail discussion group was also set up amongst project partners in June 2003. A series of project meetings between UK partners and the key Guyanese partner of Iwokrama International Centre for Rain Forest Conservation and Development have continued throughout the six month period. Dr. Graham Watkins visited the UK in June and gave a presentation to The Wildfowl & Wetlands Trust staff, Royal Holloway University of London project staff and Open University project staff concerning management issues within the project study area. In September 2003 work commenced on developing the training manuals and presentations required later on in the project. Advertisements for the nine field based positions and the MSc student position have been written in October 2003 and will be circulated within Guyana in view of recruiting staff in December 2003.
