The Mountain Chicken, or Crapaud, is one of the largest frogs in the world and is now found only in Dominica and Montserrat. Disease is hitting Crapaud numbers hard and it is now considered at risk from extinction. We do not know what effect the disease is having on Dominica's other frogs.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- *Do not hunt or eat the Mountain Chicken - it is now against the law*
- *Do not touch or disturb these frogs if you find them*
- *Never move a frog from one area or island to another*
- *Please report any sightings of Mountain Chickens - healthy, sick or dead, to:*
