April-Sepember, 07: Vietnamese Darwin trainee conducts PhD at Tubingen University; 2 Vietnamese MSc students conduct studies with Neil Furey in Vietnam

May, 07: Co-hosted with Prince of Songkla University and Texas Tech University the First International South-East Asian Bat Conference. Based in Thailand and with post conference field studies in Vietnam and Thailand, the conference attracted 120 delegates (50 students) from 25 countries and included 89 presentations (oral and poster)

August, 07: dissemination of key project outputs at 14<sup>th</sup> International Bat Conference in Mexico – presentation given by Dr Tigga Kingston
