Lamiaceae

Field characters:

Leaves opposite, no stipules, flowers usually two lipped and colorful. Fruits drupes or mericarps with an enlarged or colorful calyx

Confused with:

Rubiaceae

Fused interpetiolar stipules, regular flowers, inferior ovary Solanaceae

usually alternate leaves, fruit a berry, lots of seed, 5 stamens often with pores

Apocynaceae

White sap, twisted petals, colleters on petiole base and adjoining stem, seed usually with tuft of hairs; androecium and avnoecium sometimes fused

Rutaceae

Regular flowers, corolla and calyx lobes free, leaves often alternate, compound

Description:

Habit: Herbs, shrubs, trees or lianas.

Sap: absent. Stipules: absent.

Leaves: opposite, decussate, simple or palmately (rarely pinnately) compound; often with gland tipped hairs or sessile glands.

Inflorescences: determinate, terminal or axillary, cymose or thyrsoid.

Flowers: zygomorphic, bisexual, usually tubular and 2-lipped;

stamens: 2 or 4, exceeding the corolla tube Ovary: superior, style: terminal or gynobasic.

Fruit: with 2 carpels but often appearing 4-locular (parted) because a false division is formed by the ingrowth of the carpel wall, 1 ovule per locus. (2-) 4 nutlets or drupe; seeds: (2-)4 nutlets or in a drupe 1-4 (7) stones.

Gmelina Trees, shrubs or liana with leaves with two big

basal glands; Large showy corolla.

Peronema Leaves pinnate often with winged leaf rachis:

two fertile stamens.

Premna trees, shrubs or lianas, simple leaves

Inflorescence terminal; corolla regular to

zygomorphic, 4 lobes.

Petraeovitex Lianas with palmate leaves, fruiting calyx with

5 greatly enlarged lobes (wings).

Sphenodesme Liana with simple leaves, 6 Involucral bracts;

corolla actinomorphic.

Tectona Big trees with stellate hairs on large leaves;

large inflated papery calyx when in fruit.
