The project acceptance letter from the Darwin Initiative was received on 12 August 2021, and the first two advance requests (for Q2 Jul-Sep and Q3 Oct-Dec) were submitted on 14 September. We were therefore primarily focused on project inception during the reporting period; agreeing sub-grants with partners, reviewing the log frame, recruiting for one new field position, and revising the work plan. As a results of these efforts, a Change Request will be submitted before the end of 2021 to notify the Darwin Initiative of possible material changes we would like to make to the project, including the log frame.

Although we had originally planned for the project to start in July, no notable problems or unexpected developments have been encountered beyond the delayed start.

The project was designed during the pandemic, and the field operations of WWT and our partners have already been adapted to the demands on the pandemic and in line with appropriate health and safety measures, both internal to each organisation and those issued by the Government of Madagascar. For these reasons, we have not needed to make any material alterations to the logical framework, specific activities or operational modalities of the project as a result of the pandemic, although the situation is constantly under review.
