Field Manager of the existing project (15/005), Dr. Birgit Fessl, resigned her position in August 2009 following completion of three years excellent service. The last period of the first project (with financial extension into Year 4) and first months of this project (start date 1<sup>st</sup> July 2009) were spent completing outputs (Action Plan, published papers, and two student theses). The job of field manager to replace Birgit was advertised widely in Spanish and English and from the 28 applications three applicants were pre-selected for interviews (by phone). Francesca Cunninghame was offered the position for her wide experience in the field of translocation (in New Zealand) and her excellent Spanish skills. Francesca began work on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2009 and visited Durrell's headquarters in Jersey (3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> November) meeting Glyn Young, Birgit Fessl and Durrell personnel for planning meetings before flying out to Ecuador.
