Welcome & congratulations

- Round 20 just completed
- 282 applications received at Stage 1
- 64 applicants invited to Stage 2
- 21 new main projects funded
- 50 applications for Darwin Plus
- 15 new Darwin Plus projects funded



Evolution of the Darwin Initiative

- Launched in 1992 at the Rio Earth Summit
- Aim to help developing countries implement the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)
- 2003 introduced post-projects, scoping awards and fellowships.
- 2008 widened scope to include CITES and CMS
- Since 2010 focus on development and poverty alleviation
- 2013 focus on illegal wildlife trade



Darwin and the UK OTs

- 2009 Darwin funding ring-fenced for projects in the UK OTs
- Challenge Fund established (to scope out main round applications)
- 2012 Darwin Plus Fund established
 - Dedicated fund for environment projects in the OTs
 - co-funded by Defra, DFID and FCO
 - To date has funded 29 projects totalling £3.7m



- DARWIN INITIATIVE
- Over £106m invested since 1992 in 908 projects working in 159 countries
- Over 1500 species or habitat management plans
- Over 2000 peer review papers
- Around 700 species reference collections
- Around £5m value of physical assets handed over to host country(s)
- Over £50m resources leveraged as a result of Darwin projects



The Future of Darwin

Defra remains committed to the Darwin Initiative

 Recognising the strength of Darwin, this support is now supplemented by commitment from DFID.

Next round of funding expected Summer 2014.


